ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Required Documents:

1. Valid state ID or driver's license

Highly Recommended Documents:

1. High school diploma/ GED diploma

Orientation (*This is scheduled before the semester starts*)—New enrollees must attend the Mandatory Orientation before starting the semester.

Math Class (Fall & Winter Semesters) — We offer math classes for all enrollees, but there is an additional cost.

TRADE SCHOOL SEMESTER BREAKDOWN

FALL (ALL LEVELS) - *ENROLLMENT for the Fall semester begins in February and ends in June.*

The Fall semester begins in July and ends in December. Trainees complete their first semester depending on the level they enroll in (1.1, 2.1, 3.1, and 4.1). Classes run Monday through Thursday for 4 hours. Students attend class once a week. (*Times may vary due to the instructor's teaching*) (*Some Saturdays might be mandatory depending on trade*).

SPRING (Continuation from the Fall Semester) - *NO OPEN ENROLLMENT, it is a continuation of the Fall semester*

The Spring semester begins in January and ends in June. The Spring semester is the continuation of the Fall semester and trainees do their second part of the level they previously completed (1.2, 2.2, 3.2, and 4.2). Classes run Monday through Thursday for 4 hours. Students attend class once a week. (Times may vary due to the instructor's teaching) (Some Saturdays might be mandatory depending on trade).

FALL & SPRING Saturday Make-Up Days - Trainees are only allowed to miss 12 hours per semester for **EMERGENCY PURPOSE ONLY**. Missed hours need to be made up on the assigned Saturday make-up days (**No Exceptions**).

(If scheduled for make-up day, there is a \$125 fee that is billed regardless of student attendance)

WINTER (LEVEL 1 ONLY) (ELECTRICAL ONLY) - *ENROLLMENT for the Winter semester begins in August and ends in November*

The Winter semester is **ONLY** for level 1. It is 6 months long, running from January through June. (**Trainees complete the ENTIRE level 1 in 6 months**) Classes are once a week for 4 hours. There are an additional 11 Mandatory Saturday classes (*Times may vary due to the instructor's teaching*)

WINTER Saturday Make-Up Days (ELECTRICAL ONLY) - Trainees are only allowed to miss 24 hours per semester for **EMERGENCY PURPOSE ONLY**. Missed hours need to be made up on the assigned Saturday make-up days (**No Exceptions**). There are three mandatory Saturday make-up days and start from 6:00 am to 2:30 pm. (*If scheduled for make-up day, there is a \$125 fee that is billed regardless of student attendance*)

- SPRING (January – May): **\$200.00** monthly for 5 months: **\$1,000.00** (All levels (1) – Continuation of Fall semester (Second Semester) **Must have completed the previous Fall semester**)

- ABC SOCAL: **\$100.00** at time of enrollment
includes \$25 for the State's enrollment fee (ET card - Electrical only)

Self-Pay Tuition Rates:

- WINTER (January – June): **\$325.00** monthly for 6 months: **\$1,950.00** (ENTIRE first year; Level 1 ONLY)
- FALL (July – November): **\$400.00** monthly for 5 months: **\$2,000.00** (All levels (2 through 4) – First Semester)
- SPRING (January – May): **\$400.00** monthly for 5 months: **\$2,000.00** (All levels (2 through 4) – Continuation of Fall semester (Second Semester) **Must have completed the previous Fall semester**)

- MATH CLASS: **\$225.00** (ABC Member) or **\$325.00** (Self-Pay) (Optional)
- OSHA 30 : **\$200.00** (All current / New trainees) *(Mandatory to Graduate)*
